On 11 July 2000 I was examined orally on all areas of German law (Rigorousum) by a Committee of Professors of the Law School of the University of Munich consisting of Prof. Dr. Moris Lehner, Prof. Dr. Lorenz Schulz and Prof. Dr. Claus-Wilhelm Canaris. The thesis was rated by Prof. Dr. Dr. h.c. mult. Claus-Wilhelm Canaris with "summa cum laude" and from the second examiner, Prof. Dr. Gerhard Ries also with "summa cum laude". In the oral exam I was also awarded the grade "summa cum laude". The thesis was published in 2001 in Munich by the publishing house C.H. Beck in the official series of writings of the Law School of the University of Munich (Münchener Universitätsschriften: Reihe der Juristischen Fakultät, Bd. 156). The necessary prerequisite for the publication of a thesis in this scientific series is that it has been graded by both examiners with "summa cum laude". Its publication was funded by the University of Munich. The publishing house informed me that the copies were sold out in the first years of publication. My doctoral thesis is systematically referred to, inter alia, by Staudinger Kommentar and Münchener Kommentar.

## **12. PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE**

- As of December 2001 until today I am a Legal Counsel of the Bank of Greece with a mandate of indefinite duration and I provide legal advice on banking law issues. Since June 2013 I have been assigned the duties of Head of the Credit System Supervision Department of the Legal Services Directorate of the Bank of Greece with responsibility for all legal issues arising during the supervision of the Bank of Greece over credit and financial institutions as well as for legal issues arising from the Single Supervisory Mechanism by the European Central Bank and the resolution or liquidation of credit institutions. During the economic crisis I participated in the

drafting of many laws and legal acts – both individual and regulatory – for the restructuring of the banking system and then in their practical implementation by the Bank of Greece. I represent in court (in particular in the Council of State) the Bank of Greece in cases of major importance (e.g. withdrawal of licences for the operation of credit institutions and sanctions to supervised entities in the financial sector).
